GENERAL IMPRESSION

Priorities for care are inconsistent with the identified impression of the patient's stability. (1 point)		
Unable to identify the relative stability of the patient. (0 points)		
PATIENT ASSESSMENT		
Conducts a history and physical exam that is relevant to the patient's chief complaint and chronic history. (4 points)	4	
Assessment flow is generally linear or sequential, but the candidate is able to adapt some questions to the patient's chief complaint and chronic history. (2 points)		
Completes a history and physical exam but does not adapt the exam to the patient's chief complaint or chronic history. (1 point)		
The history and/or physical exam is only partially performed or is not performed at all. (0 points)		
FIELD IMPRESSION/CRITICAL THINKING		
Identifies the primary cause for the patient's acute presentation and is able to logically defend their decision with specific findings. (4 points)	4	
Identifies the primary cause for the patient's acute presentation with the correct findings, but their rationale is vague. (2 points)		
Identifies the primary cause for the patient's acute presentation but the rationale is incorrect. (1 point)		
Unable to identify the correct field impression. (0 points)		
TREATMENT PLAN (After Initial Care)		
Implements an appropriate treatment plan and assesses for expected actions and side effects of each medication/treatment. (4 points)	4	
Implements an appropriate treatment plan but only assesses for expected actions of each medication. (2 points)		
Implements an appropriate treatment plan without any further assessment. (1 point)		
Identifies the wrong treatment plan or treats all signs/symptoms without considering the underlying cause for them. (0 points)
